ASCL – POLICY STATEMENT

The programme of courses run by Snowsport England and hosted by Interski are heavily subsidised. Our motives are twofold. Firstly, we contribute to the growing pool of qualified party leaders by widening the accessibility of the ASCL training, which we see as beneficial to school/college snowsport participation in general. Secondly, it enables us to showcase our operation to existing, new and aspiring party leaders, not as a 'hard sell', but simply by enabling our activities to be witnessed at first-hand.

In order to safeguard the value of this initiative and to ensure that participants are suitably prepared and adequately skilled, we insist that they meet with the course requirements and ability levels, as stated by Snowsport England. We must stress that these standards are unlikely to have been reached with less than 6-7 weeks skiing experience. You should be able to ski a minimum of 5 hours per day and be able to ski in all conditions.

An honest and fair declaration of competence will avoid the embarrassment of skill inadequacy leading to exclusion from the course and an invitation to return home immediately at personal expense without refund. If you are in any doubt whatsoever about your individual level of skiing ability, please seek further advice from Snowsport England and avoid (1) wasting the opportunity (2) denying the opportunity to another candidate.
