IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING SNOWSPORT SCHOOL GROUPINGS

Please find enclosed/attached a Ski Party Information Sheet for your group travelling to the Aosta Valley with Interski this winter. We would kindly ask you to read the enclosed/attached instructions on how to complete the form, which should be returned to us no later than 10 weeks prior to your departure. You may already have received an electronic version - please feel free to use whichever version is most convenient for you.

If you have travelled with Interski previously, you will note that we are no longer asking for skiing abilities to be listed on this sheet. Simply tick whether lessons are required (there may be staff, for example, who do not require formal lessons).

In an effort to make the process of allocating students/staff to ski groups more efficient, and enabling you to take friendship groups into account, we are now asking you to provide your own suggested groupings. This can be done using the form enclosed/attached or you can simply provide your own lists. We suggest this is done approximately one month prior to departure so that your groupings take into account any dry slope sessions in which the students may have been involved. We suggest you work on a maximum of 10 per ski group. In an effort to make classes viable, where you may only have a few students of a particular standard, please note that they are likely to be mixed with students of the same ability from another school.

Feel free to use your own description of standards (the more information you can provide, the better) - eg, Group 1 : have had 6 hours experience on plastic. Group 2: never skied at all. Group 3: all got Interski 5 star awards last year. Please clearly identify under a separate category the ability levels of any snowboarders as well as names of anyone not requiring instruction.

Please forward your completed forms/your own lists to our UK office by email, fax or post. In the event of any related issues, you will be contacted prior to departure by Emma Stocks, Head of Snowsport School, who will discuss options with you to ensure that your group receive the maximum benefit from their experience.
