COURSE STRUCTURE



Week 1

The course starts with a week's technical training in Courmayeur. This will be delivered by a BASI L4 or national equivalent. The week will run from 09:30 to 16:00 Monday through to Friday

Week 2

This week will be all about Off Piste Mountain Safety and navigation in preparation for the Exam in Chamonix the following week

Week 3

Off piste Mountain Safety Exam / Chamonix. This is your chance to put your newly learnt skills to the test, literally! We can supply you with a Mont Blanc Tunnel pass at cost so you can travel through to Chamonix each day. The travel time is roughly 30 mins. Alternatively, if you decide the exam is not for you just yet, we can organise a week's teaching in Courmayeur

Week 4

A further week of technical training. The week will run from 09:30 to 16:00 Monday through to Friday

Week 5 - 7

February is here and it's the opportunity to take on three weeks work, with the live out allowance you can earn back €840 in this short period working for the Interski Snowsport School

Week 8 - 9

The final two weeks of technical training before the L3 Technical and Teaching exam! The weeks will run from 09:30 to 16:00 Monday through to Friday

Week 10

Your opportunity to sit the BASI L3 technical course in Courmayeur

Week 11

Your opportunity to sit the BASI L3 teaching course in Courmayeur

Week 12

Your opportunity to sit the BASI Adaptive L1 course in Pila and complete your 2nd discipline.

Week 13 - 16

The final 4 weeks of the course provide you with the opportunity to work for the Interski Snowsports School.

TECHNICAL TRAINING

The technical training team is made up from BASI L4 ISTDs and current BASI Trainers, who are BASI L3 technical and teaching assessors. You will therefore have a wealth of experience and knowledge to call upon.

The technical training weeks will run Monday to Friday, with an 09:30 start, skiing through until 16:00, with around 1 hour for lunch. The weeks will be challenging mentally and physically. However, your all round progress and understanding will develop rapidly!

Training throughout the course will cover all the necessary technical assessment areas - piste performance, variables, bumps and steeps. We have also included a week of off-piste mountain safety training.

The mountain safety training will follow the same format as the technical training weeks. You will be out with your trainer Monday – Friday for full days. You will cover areas including snow and avalanche risk assessment, off-piste skiing, technique, equipment used for touring and off-piste travel, map reading, navigation and route selection.

It sits on the Italian side of Mont Blanc, western Europe's highest mountain, which it shares with Chamonix on the French side. The scenery is spectacular and the skiing varied. The Freeride World Tour stops at Courmayeur each year and only adds to the resort's kudos. You have a season lift pass for the Aosta Valley which not only covers Courmayeur but also covers Champoluc, Cervinia, Pila, La Thuile, La Rosiere (in France) and many more. In addition the Aosta Valley pass also covers unlimited use of the SkyWay lift!



ACCOMMODATION

HOME SWEET HOME

The self catered accommodation for the course is located in Palleusieux, a short five minute drive (3.5km) from Courmayeur centre. There is also a conveniently located bus stop with regular shuttles to the centre.

The apartment is modern, boasts two twin bedrooms, bathroom, modern kitchen, lounge, Wi-Fi and 1 car parking space. With views looking at Monte Bianco, we're confident you'll feel right at home at this brilliantly located apartment.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW CAN YOU OFFER THE COURSE SO MUCH CHEAPER THAN THE OTHER COMPANIES?

We are the biggest UK tour operator in the Aosta Valley. We pass on to you the benefit of our bulk purchasing power and existing infrastructure in resort.

IS YOUR TRAINING RUN BY L4 ISTD'S?

Yes, our training weeks are run by minimum BASI L4 ISTD coaches/national equivalent.

ARE YOU A BASI EUROPEAN BUSINESS PARTNER?

DO YOU INCLUDE WINTER SPORTS INSURANCE?

We don't offer winter sports insurance for this particular course.

DO I HAVE ANY TIME OFF DURING THE COURSE?

Weekends are free, unless you're working for the Interski Snowsport School.

WILL I BE PAID FOR THE WEEKS I TEACH FOR THE INTERSKI SNOWSPORT SCHOOL?

Of course. You will be provided with exactly the same package as other instructors. The more weeks you work, the more money you will earn!

IS A SEASON LIFT PASS INCLUDED?

Yes! An Aosta Valley ski pass is included. Covering up to 22 resorts, including Cervinia, La Thuile, La Rosiere (in France), Pila and Champuluc. The ski pass also includes unlimited use of the SkyWay lift in Courmayeur.

ARE BASI COURSE FEES INCLUDED WITHIN THE PROGRAMME?

The course fees are deliberately not included to allow greater flexibility to the programme.

IS LUNCH INCLUDED?

No, lunch is not included. However, we can supply lunch vouchers at an additional cost, which can be used at a number of mountain restaurants.

HOW FAR IS THE APARTMENT FROM COURMAYEUR?

A short five minute drive (3.5km) from Courmayeur centre. There is also a conveniently located bus stop with regular shuttles to the centre of Courmayeur.

IS THERE A SECURITY DEPOSIT FOR THE APARTMENT?

Yes. Due to the apartment cost, we have to take a €250 deposit per person.

IS THE APARTMENT CLEANED?

The apartment is cleaned twice weekly and bedding changed weekly.

IS PARKING AVAILABLE AT THE APARTMENT?

There is space for one car at the apartment. Alternative parking is available near by.

DOES THE PACKAGE INCLUDE FOOD?

The package is self-catering with one evening meal provided per week in a nearby restaurant in Courmayeur.

IS TRANSPORT PROVIDED?

Transport to and from resort is not included. We can provide transfers to and from Geneva/Turin at an additional cost.

WHERE CAN I STORE MY SKIS?

Storage is provided out of the Interski Ski Hire in Courmayeur, on the mountain.

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED?

Whilst in Courmayeur, transport to and from the slopes - Lunch - Winter sports insurance - Any travel to and from the resort - BASI course fees - Ski touring equipment hire - flights
