PART TIME ROLES

SKI INSTRUCTOR

ROLE DESCRIPTION

- Interski require part time ski instructors to work on a week-to-week basis
- Instructors will be required to attend instructor meetings / briefings on a daily basis and will instruct from 5 days per week, 24 hours of teaching and 5 hours of lunchtime supervision over the week
- Peak weeks are the weeks commencing 04.02.2023, 11.02.2023, 18.02.2023, 25.03.2023, 01.04.2023, 08.04.2023
- High demand weeks are the weeks commencing 16.12.2022, 21.01.2023, 25.02.2023
- To teach in Aosta/Pila, Courmayeur or La Thuile

SEASONAL ROLES

SKI INSTRUCTOR

ROLE DESCRIPTION

- Interski require 15 ski instructors for the 2022-23 winter season
- Instructors will mainly work with our School & College clients teaching skiing from Monday to Friday (24 hours of teaching, 5 hours of lunchtime supervision)
- Work in the role as a Resort Team Member (i.e., Ski Hire / Transfer / Welcome Meetings) on Sundays
- There may be the odd week where 15 instructors are not required to teach therefore some instructors may be required to work in a resort team role for the week
- Instructors will be based in Aosta and will teach in Pila, Courmayeur and La Thuile

SNOWSPORTS SCHOOL CO-ORDINATOR

ROLE DESCRIPTION

- The Snowsports School Co-ordinator will co-ordinate the on-hill operations in resort. The Snowsports School Co-ordinator will review snowsports school requirements, liaise with Party Leaders with regards to requirement, plan and build the snowsports school, manage instructors and ensure all clients receive the correct standard of tuition in a safe environment.
- The Snowsports School Co-ordinator will liaise with party leaders prior to arrival in resort, confirming arrangements on arrival and throughout the week to ensure they are happy with all on hill operations.
- The Snowsports School Co-ordinator role includes organisation, preplanning and delivering information to instructors as well as the awareness of the standards set out by Interski for the instructors. The Snowsports School Co-ordinator will need to address instructors when standards are not met.
- The Snowsports School Co-ordinator will need to build strong relationships with instructor hotels and restaurants (off hill and mountain).
- The Snowsports School Co-ordinator will be ideally qualified as a minimum of a BASI ISIA Instructor (or working towards qualifications) as there will be a requirement to instruct throughout the season.
- Instruction will be required for clients (junior snowsports school, adult lessons, private lessons) and resort staff.
- This role will be Aosta/Pila based
- Conversational Italian or French is beneficial
