As accolades go, offering the highest skiing in the Pyrenees is not too bad for this tidy resort. Boi Taull may not be the most famous of ski resorts, but its lack of fame is a huge benefit for anyone else visiting who will be all but guaranteed the enjoyment of quiet and peaceful slopes in this quaint Spanish resort. Spain itself is unfortunately not renowned for its ski resorts, but the Pyrenees boasts some incredible winter sports destinations.

Skiing starts at just over 2000m and climbs to a just above 2750m, offering incredible views of the surrounding mountains and valleys. The efficient lift system ensures that queues are rare

and although this may not be the biggest resort, it has plenty of piste available to keep skiers of all abilities entertained.

Learning to ski here is a pleasure. The generally milder climate in the Pyrenees, when compared with the Alps, means an easier introduction to the mountains enabling beginners to enjoy the sunshine and snow at the same time.

A choice of mountain restaurants and a range of hotel accommodation nearby makes Boi Taull a solid choice for your school ski trip.
