Originally existing as 6 separate ski resorts - Pas de la Casa, Grau Roig, Soldeu, El Tarter, Canillo, Encamp - each requiring a different lift pass and only offering a small(ish) area. In 2010 after some careful planning a grand vision was realised to combine them all and create one enormous ski area known as Grandvalira. This means one lift pass now covers the whole area, but visitors can still choose which of the resorts, or sectors, they would like to stay in. Each offers something different and so visitors can tailor their holiday perfectly. There's an incredible choice of hotels with Andorra reputed to offer over 40,000 hotel beds!

There's no less than 210km of piste, with a great mix of tree-lined skiing and open bowls. The longest run is a whopping 8km and the intricate design of each and every slope allows for great progression and makes most areas accessible to all standards. Hotels are available in all the original sectors, giving you the choice of where to stay and where to access this enormous resort. It's also possible to stay in Andorra's cosmopolitan capital, Andorra La Vella.
