Pal Arinsal is located in an Andorran valley that runs in a northerly direction. The ski area actually combines the two individual resorts of Pal and Arinsal, both included on the same lift pass, and linked by cable car.

Arinsal is more of a bowl, the skiing is superb and affords some brilliant views down the Valley. The progression is great and offers skiing for all abilities. Pal has more tree-lined skiing and a greater overall length of piste, with a brilliant mix of gradients, again suitable for all abilities. The slopes are accessed by the main gondola in the middle of the village or there is a charlift at the top of the village.

Arinsal is a small but lively village with plenty of bars and restaurants and an energetic après-ski scene. There are plenty of hotels to choose from, all in the village or a very short walk to the gondola.

Pal is accessed by a main cable car which runs from the village of La Massana. A small but busy village, there is a great choice of hotels all within easy walking distance of the cable car and the village also offers a superb choice of cafes, bars and restaurants as well as a really nice central square.
